


Ability to extend Lease end date

Description: As a user, I can use the **Lease Extension** option to extend my lease within the notice period so that any renewed lease would have updated information in LAM




Maintenance Event Timeline: add optimal scenario along with operational days

Description: The Maintenance Event Timeline has been enhanced to include optimal scenarios concerning operational days, so that users can decide on when to perform the maintenance events, reducing downtime whilst allowing for fleet optimisation.



Enhanced access control

Description: As a user, I am able to control who has access for each lease so that only the concerned person can see the lease contract details.





Opening multiple documents in separate windows without reload

Description: Auditors can now open multiple documents in separate modules (MCC, MH, CS, Boxsearch, Goods In, etc.) without page reload, making it easier to view and interact with multiple documents simultaneously without losing progress or opening separate windows.

Now, users can open multiple documents at the same time, instead of having one single document viewer window that it is reloaded when a new document is opened. This change has been made available in the modules Maintenance History, Current Status, Maintenance Control Centre, Box Search and Goods In, allowing the verification process to be faster and more efficient.

Print option in box search

Description: As a user, I want to print some of the documents just by box searching them on platform so that I could easily use in auditing or binder preparation.

UI: Search>> Manage Documents >> Print

Here, after selecting multiple documents, click on print option. The below pop up will appear where you select require options and save.
